

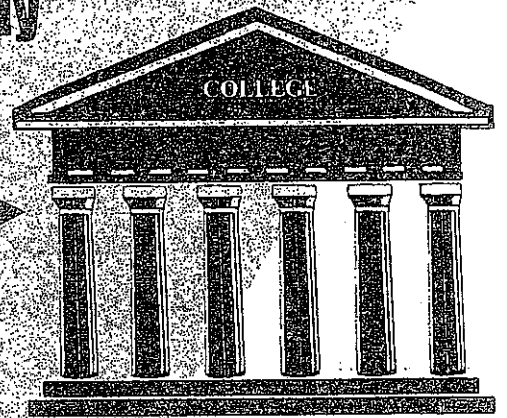

Is Your High School Experience Ready for More?

If you are looking for more challenge, class flexibility or just want to get a head start on your post-high school career, MOWR options might be a good fit. MOWR is a process through which a high school student can take classes from a Georgia public/private university or technical college and earn credit.

There are many different options, some of which you might not be aware. In some cases, students can earn both a high school diploma and college credit at the same time and tuition for the classes will be provided through Georgia Student Finance Commission if students are enrolled full-time at the college and meet the eligibility criteria set by the college.

*Student must meet with their counselor and apply to the college by this deadline:

March 31 for Summer and Fall applications

*Student must meet with their counselor and apply to the college by this deadline:

November 30 for Spring

The student must meet College Admissions criteria in order to participate in MOWR.
